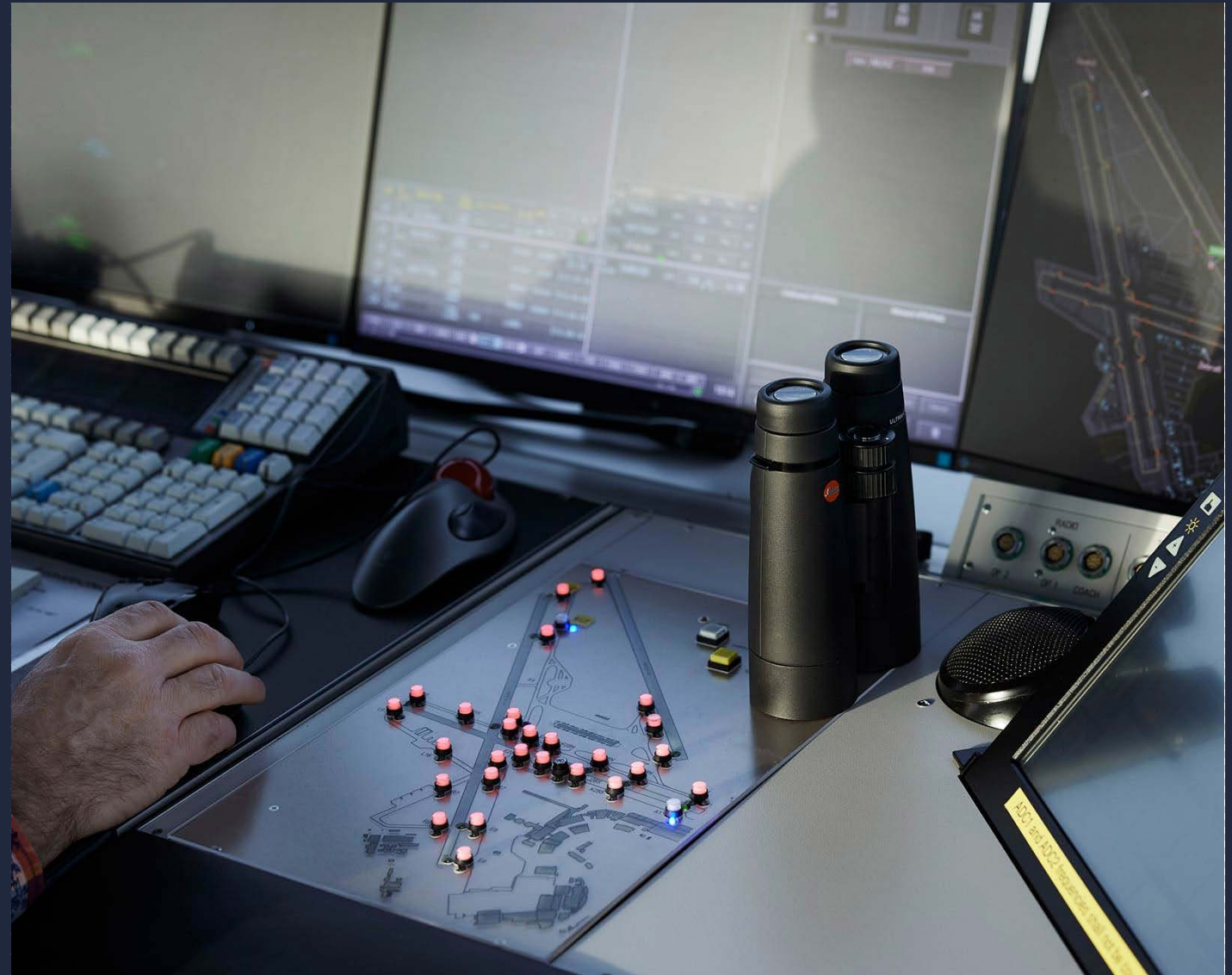
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## What are the different air traffic control services?

7/24h, 365 days since 2021
- Safeguarding air sovereignty
- Air reconnaissance and air transport
- Air Traffic Controller training



## What are the tasks of military air traffic control?

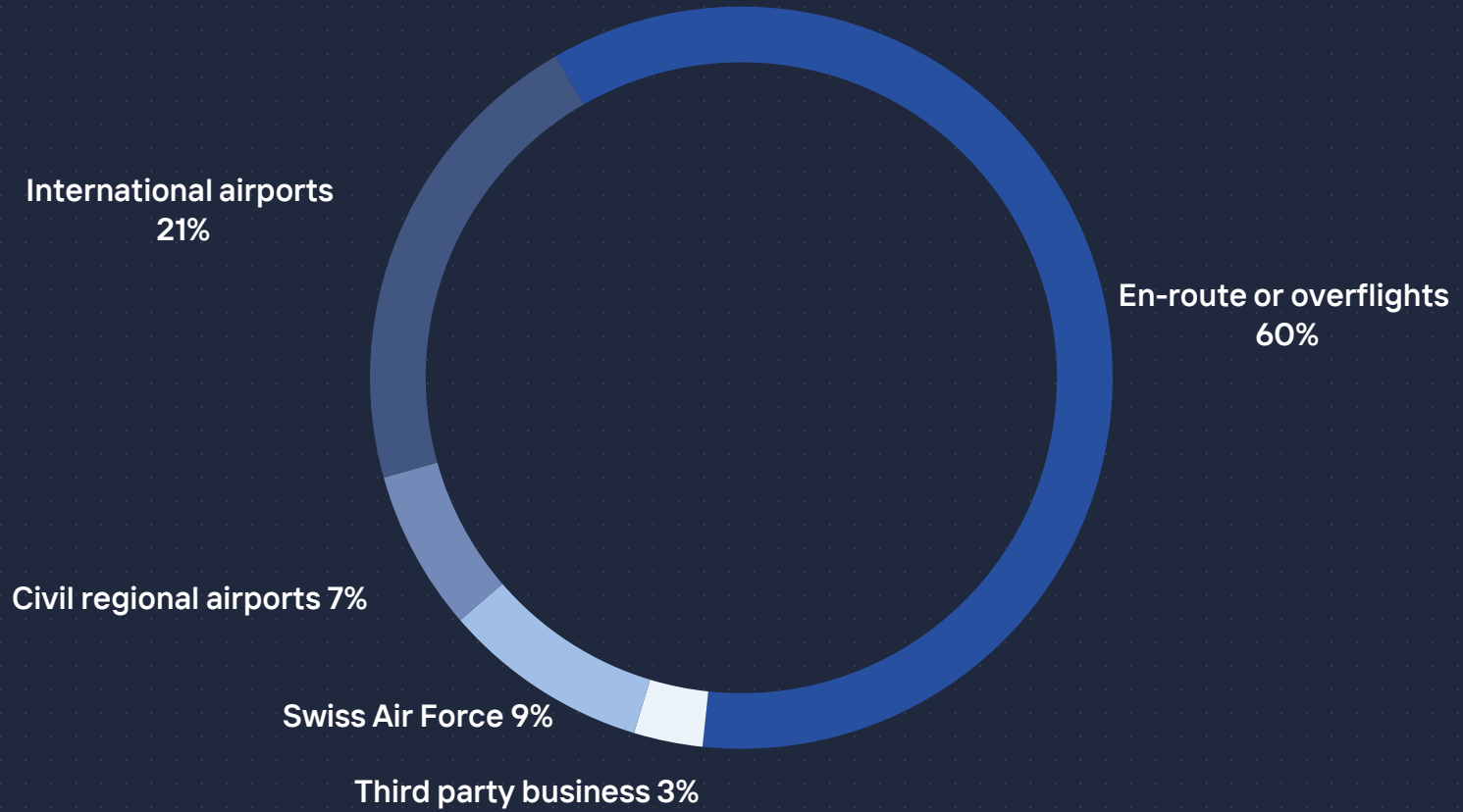
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- Tower / Approach Control of military aerodromes
- Implementation of tactical air battles by fighter controller
- Provide air situation picture and recognized Air Picture
- Support the Swiss Air Force through air defence training («Defensive Counter Air»)

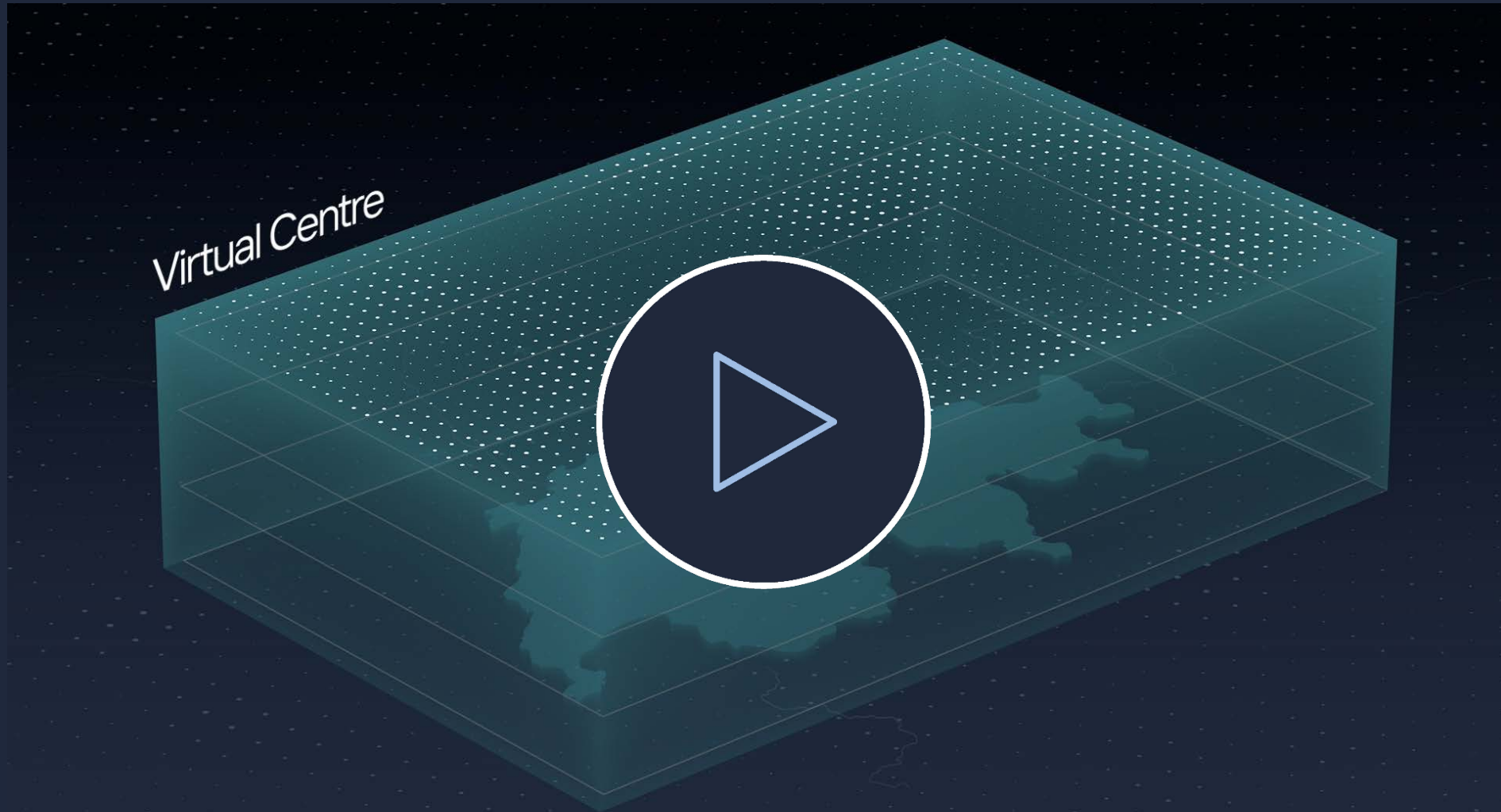
# Innovation strategy

-  From controlling to air traffic management

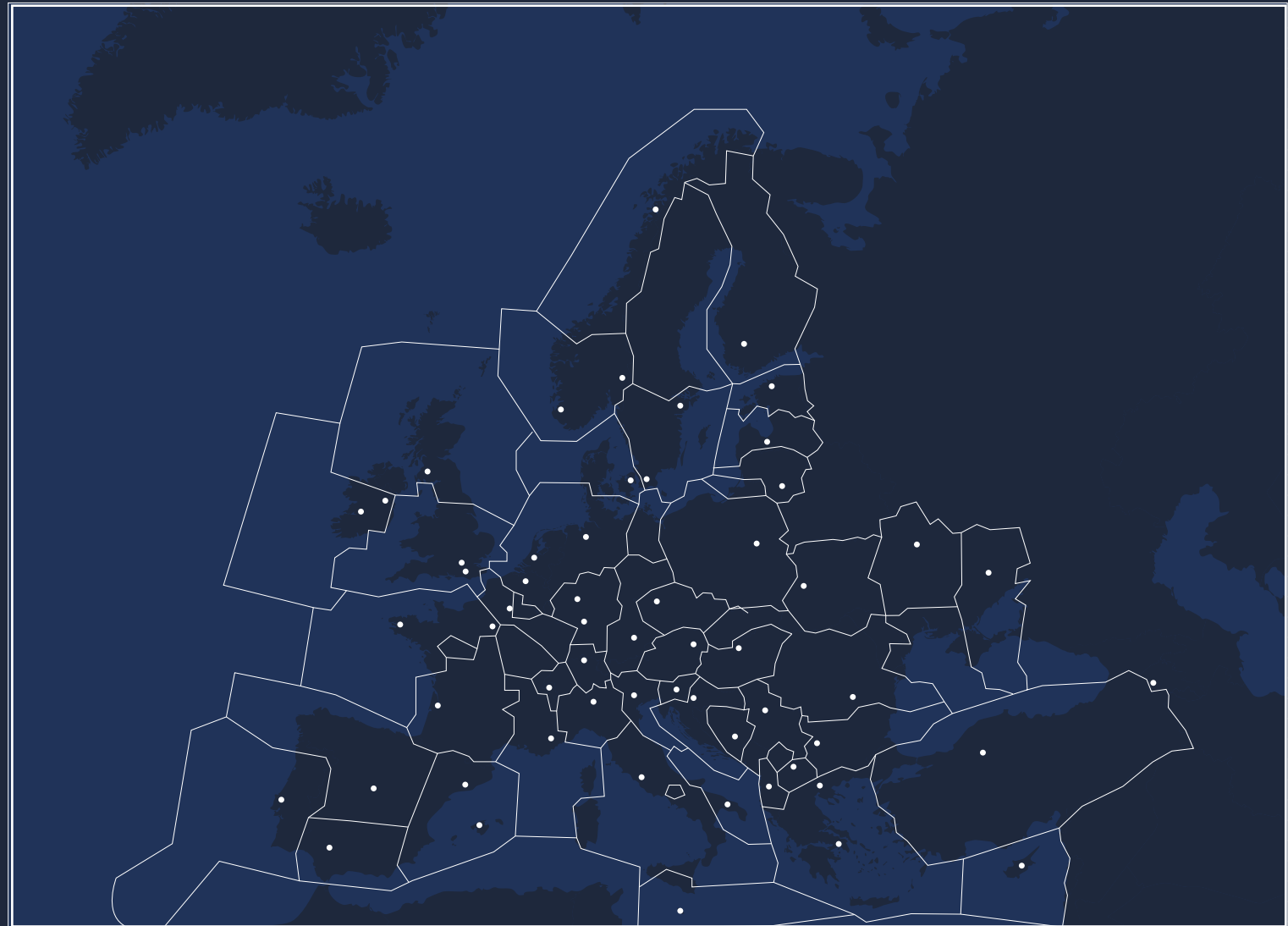
